### Financial Information

1. All fees, application, tuition, book costs are due the week prior to the class beginning.
2. All fees, tuition and books costs are subject to change without notice.
3. There is a \$25.00 non-refundable application fee that must be provided prior to your application being processed.
4. The tuition fee for each course is \$125.00. Book fees will vary per course. Book fees range from \$14.00-\$40.00 depending on the number of books assigned per course professor.

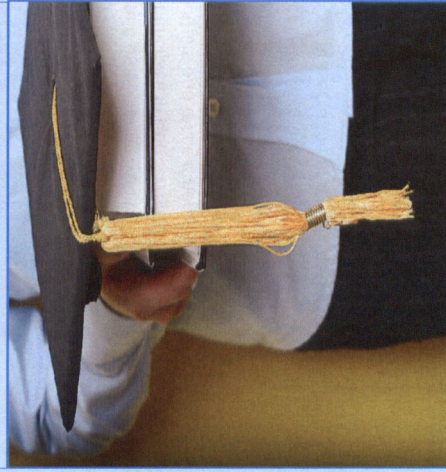

2. Registration and orientation will be held at 1206 Florida Boulevard Baton Rouge, LA 70802.
3. Student handbooks, class schedules, facility tour and informational packet will be provided during this session.
4. Classes are held Monday 10:00 a.m.-1:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.-10:00 p.m.
5. All new students must attend the orientation session, no exceptions.

### DRESS CODE

1. **Gentlemen- Acceptable Attire:**  
Uniform polo or dress slacks, dress shirt, suit, tie, dress socks, dress shoes. **Unacceptable Attire:** T-shirts, jeans, shorts, sweat-shirts, overalls, jump suits, tennis shoes, and hats. **Grooming:** Hair must be neat, well groomed, well shaven, nails must be clean/cut, and no earrings.

2. **Ladies-Acceptable Attire:** Uniform polo, dress slacks, dress pant suit, dress blouse, dress, skirt & blouse, sweaters, stockings, socks, and dress shoes. **Unacceptable Attire:** Sundresses, strapless dresses, halters, jeans, sweatshirts, culottes, capri pants, gauchos, mini skirts, shorts, leggings, tennis shoes, hats (unless medically necessary) head bands. **Grooming:** Hair must be neat, well groomed, nails must be clean and no big, long dangling earrings.

### STANDARD OF CONDUCT
